Global-level issues:

2. Please suggest ways for your peer to improve the overall format of his/her document. Pay particular attention to white space, item numbering, and use of graphics. Comment on these.

3. Returning to graphics – are the images used appropriate, effectively labeled (below each and within the text), and cited?

4. Besides a numbered set of steps, does your peer include any introductory material or “follow-up” advice? Comment.

5. After reading these instructions, how easily do you think you might be able to perform this task? If your answer is “not so easily,” what information would you still need to succeed?

Local-level issues:

1. Does your peer use simple and direct phrasing? If no, how might he/she improve this?

2. How many steps does your peer’s document include? Do these steps seem to be in a logical order, with “parallel” sentence structures (meaning, the same structure, generally, or tone, in each sentence)?

3. On your peer’s draft, be sure to mark any spelling, sentence-clarity, word-choice, and punctuation flaws.

Finally, return this sheet and your marked-up draft of your peer’s Instructions to your peer. Each person must submit a peer-review sheet, done by a peer of their assignment, with their final Instructions.
